Dear Current Seventh Grade Parent(s) or Guardian(s):

I will be sponsoring a school board approved **educational tour to Washington D.C. and Gettysburg, PA** for interested eighth grade students tentatively scheduled for **May 8-11, 2019**. I will be giving the students more information about this in September when we come back from summer vacation but I wanted to get the word out now so you can begin planning for this trip. I do not have an exact cost due to being a year away, but this past year's cost of the trip was \$505.00 per person (based on quad occupancy for sleeping arrangements). With inflation and fuel costs, I expect this trip to cost a little more. For this price each student receives:

1. Round-trip transportation in a modern air-conditioned motor coach
2. Meals
3. Tour guides on each bus
4. Hotel accommodations for two nights
5. Admission to every sightseeing event
6. Complete liability and medical coverage
7. Nighttime supervision

This program is complete and the tour costs cover everything with the exception of souvenirs and snacks. The trip is optional, but well worth the price. It will give the students the opportunity to see our government in action, appreciate our history, honor our heroes, and experience life in a big city. I hope your child will take this opportunity to travel to our nation's capital.

Payment Due Dates: These are deadlines and **MUST** be met to allow for transfer of funds to the travel company. Of course, you may pay the entire balance before the due dates if this is more convenient for you. The tour is being arranged and booked by Prodigy Student Travel LLC of Worthington, OH. **Please make all checks payable to: Morgan Local School District.**

1st Deposit of \$100.00 (amt/person) due on November 2, 2018

Final Balance Due on February 1, 2019

We are having a fundraiser which will be offered in the fall. Information will be given to the students in August about this fundraiser. Please take advantage of this money making opportunity.
